St Catherine's Triathlon 2026

Race Director's Report

The June edition of the St Catherine's Triathlon took place on Saturday 13 June 2026, with racing getting underway at 18:40 following athlete briefing and safety preparations.

Despite a number of local athletes competing off-island at other events, turnout was excellent, reflecting the continued strength and enthusiasm of the Jersey triathlon community. Conditions were near perfect for racing, with a beautiful sunny evening providing a fantastic backdrop for the race.

Athletes competed across Sprint (750m/20km/5km) and Super Sprint (400m/10km/2.5km) triathlon distances as well as both Sprint and Super Sprint Aquabike races.

Sprint Race

The race was won by DC Swart in 1:07:28, followed by Paul Butt in 1:08:37 and Peter Holmes in 1:09:30. Pete Holmes was first out of the swim closely followed by Dave Holmes entering T1 together. Strong rides from DC Swart and Paul Butt narrowed the gap into the final leg with DC Swart securing victory with a solid run leg in just under 19 minutes. Katie Tanguy took the victory honours in the ladies placing 6th overall in 1:18:31 with Adele Maher maintaining the advantage to take 2nd place following an impressive swim.

Super sprint Race

Monika Markowska won in an impressive 49:50, with Emily Paton second in 51:44 and David Carter third 52:04.

Aquabike & other categories

Paul Corcoran won the Aquabike in 51:53.

Special mention has to go to Alexis Dolling for sacrificing her own swim to support a fellow competitor during the swim whilst the rescue crew were able to get to them and also battling through equipment malfunctions to complete the bike leg.
